Additional Information, If Applicable:

To be considered for Financial Aid, candidates must complete an Admission Application by January 15<sup>th</sup> as well as submit a financial aid application through SSS by February 1<sup>st</sup> with supporting documents by February 15<sup>th</sup>.

If these dates have passed, please submit your information as soon as possible. Each year due to high demand and increased competition for financial aid, the financial aid budget is typically exhausted by May 1<sup>st</sup>. It is important to note that returning students who do not apply or receive financial aid their first year are unlikely to receive aid in the following years.
