

STUDENT COVID-19 TESTING DATES

January 2021

As part of our safe campus reentry plan, all students must be tested at least twice before starting the school year in person. Your testing dates will depend on your arrival:

- Test #1: Taken either on campus, or up to 72 hours prior to your arrival on campus
- Test #2: On campus

Students who test positive for COVID-19 on either test may not resume the school year in person, and must attend remotely.

TEST #1

For test #1, families may elect to have testing with their own primary care physician or use one of our on-campus testing days, which we're offering for your convenience or in case you are unable to secure a test from your PCP.

TEST #1 may be taken EITHER:

On Campus

Test results may take 24-48 hours.

Boarding students staying on campus during winter break, or arrive prior to Jan. 4: **Monday, Jan. 4**

Boarders who arrive between Jan. 4-8: Friday, Jan. 8

Boarding students arriving on Jan. 9 or 10, and all Upper and Middle School day students: **Monday, Jan. 11**

Through your own primary care physician

OR

Boarding students arriving on Jan. 15 must take a test on January 11 or 12, 72 hours prior to your arrival on campus.

Note: The test must be a **COVID 19 PCR Molecular Test.**

TEST #2

Test #2 must be taken **on campus.** Test results may take 24-48 hours.

Students who stayed on campus during winter break or arrived prior to Jan. 4: **Friday, Jan. 8**

Students who arrived early and took their first test on Jan. 8: Monday, Jan. 11

Boarding students who took their first test on Jan. 11, or through their own primary care physician, and all Upper and Middle School day students: **Friday. Jan. 15**
