

To earn a STEM Concentration, students must:

- Complete a Williston Scholars class in either math or science.
- Engage in at least five “units” of extracurricular STEM activities (Each bullet can only count for a maximum of 2 units)
 - Tutoring in the Math Resource Center (1 year)
 - Two trimesters count as 1 unit
 - ARETE Tutor (Math or Science)
 - Two trimesters count as 1 unit
 - Math team
 - Organize at least three math team social events
 - Math competitions
 - NEML + AMC + At least one off campus competition
 - Three events total will equal 1 unit
 - Science Olympiad
 - Each Olympiad competed in will count as 1 unit
 - Volunteer for Whitaker-Bement Girls in Math Competition
 - Be a member of the organizing committee will count as 1 unit
 - Robotics afternoon program
 - Two or more seasons will count as 1 unit.
 - Summer program/research/internship
 - Selection must be approved by Science or Math department
 - Each approved program will count as 1 unit
 - 15 credit sequence in one department
